

The Department for Aging and Rehabilitative Services has initiated periodic review for two regulations, Grants to Area Agencies on Aging (22 VAC 30-60) and The Virginia Public Guardian and Conservator Program (22 VAC 30-70). Executive Order 14 (2010) requires that all regulations be reviewed at least once every four years. The purpose of this review is to determine whether this regulation should be terminated, amended, or retained in its current form. Public comment is sought on the review of any issue relating to this regulation, including whether the regulation (i) is necessary for the protection of public health, safety, and welfare or for the economical performance of important governmental functions; (ii) minimizes the economic impact on small businesses in a manner consistent with the stated objectives of applicable law; and (iii) is clearly written and easily understandable.
