

Explore long-term care alternatives so you can stay at home longer



To qualify for the Community Living Program, you

- must be 65 or over
- have income at or below 300% SSI and are likely to be denied Medicaid due to excess resources
- have a caregiver that is showing difficulty meeting your needs
- are somewhat dependent in some areas of your daily care and activities
