Medicare Word Puzzles

This game is an activity to accompany *MyHealth. MyMedicare* outreach and education and is appropriate for Medicare training partners or people somewhat familiar with the Medicare program.

There are 17 word puzzles presented in PowerPoint® format. Answers appear on slide 18. You can choose to work the puzzles in teams or individually.

Suggested uses:

- Print out the word puzzles. After a designated amount of time to complete, go through the answers as a group.
- Show the puzzles as a PowerPoint® presentation, with participants writing down answers or calling them out.

This is Medicare Game Show

This game is presented in a Jeopardy-like format. It can be an excellent tool to use in the classroom to review and/or learn new content. Used as a learning activity, it serves as a review of key Medicare topics or terminology. It is appropriate for Medicare training partners and people somewhat familiar with the Medicare program.

You can choose to play in teams or individually. Suggest getting play money for awarding to participants for correct answer. Remind participants that their responses should be in the form of a question.

Medicare BINGO

There are 3 different Medicare BINGO games with 20 cards for each game and a Medicare glossary for each set. Each set was designed to accompany one of the following National Medicare Training Program's classroom training modules:

(1) Module 1A: Welcome to Medicare

This training module provides an introduction to the Medicare program for audiences of people who are, or soon will be, eligible for Medicare. This short presentation will give you an overview of the Medicare program—and let you know where you can get more information.

(2) Module 1C: Understanding Medicare

This module contains basic information about the Medicare program. It is divided into five lessons.

1. Medicare Basics (Part A and Part B)
2. Original Medicare Plan
3. Medicare Advantage Plans (Part C) and other Medicare plans
4. Medicare prescription drug coverage (Part D)
5. Programs for people with limited income and resources

(3) Module 7: Medicare Preventive Services

This module contains information on some services covered by Medicare that may help you stay healthy. These are called preventive services. Medicare pays for many preventive services to help people with Medicare live longer and healthier lives.
